

ENTRY PROCEDURE

Please expedite your check in by pre-entering! Make sure your entry is legible and complete and you have all of your membership cards. Entry form and information also online at www.kimbertonhunt.org. **Deadline for pre-entries is 6:00PM, April 25, 2009.** Secretary: Barbara Dunn, 1030 Jaine Lane, Chester Springs, PA 19425. 1. Complete and sign entry form (three signatures)
2. Bring photocopy of 12-month Negative Coggins Test.
3. Bring photocopy of USEF Membership cards for Owner, Rider, and Trainer or add \$20 non-member fee (Leadline and Shortest Stirrup Divisions are exempt from membership requirement.)
4. If applicable, photocopy amateur certification. In hunter breeding limited to TB's copy of papers.
5. Check payable to Kimberton Hunt for all fees. All classes are \$25 each with the exception of Leadline which is \$10 per class. Drug fee is \$7 and USEF fee is \$5. A \$20 grounds fee will be applied to all entries.
6. Pony measurement cards to be shown at show – no photocopies.

A \$25 LATE FEE WILL BE APPLIED TO ALL POST ENTRIES.

PONIES: Pony measurement cards (or valid measurement form) are required for Pony Hunter, Green Pony Hunter and Children's Hunter Pony Divisions. Pony measurement fee is \$40 for non-USEF members. Additional veterinarian fees are paid directly to on-call veterinarian. Measurement cards not required for Pre-Children's Hunter Pony or Equitation Divisions.

Pony Measurements will be done by the on-call veterinarian at approximately 10:00AM the day of the show. Contact the Show Secretary to schedule a measurement - horseshow@kimbertonhunt.org or 610-469-0227.

AMATEURS: USEF Amateur Certification is required for Amateur Owner and Adult Amateur Hunter Divisions.

Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Equestrian rule book will be judged in accordance herewith:

Life, senior active, and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions upon payment of a \$20 nonmember registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline with the exception of Leadline and Shortest Stirrup Divisions.

LADIES SIDE-SADDLE: Ladies Side-Saddle Division is approved by the International Side-Saddle Organization and this is a recognized ISSO show. Bonus points will be awarded accordingly to ISSO members competing for ISSO Annual Awards. Side-saddle riders are welcome in all classes.
