Please expedite your check-in by pre-entering.

- A check for full payment of all entry and miscellaneous fees or a signed open check made payable to "Kimberton Hunt Club" must either be mailed with your pre-entry or given to the secretary upon arrival to the show grounds to be kept on file in the horse show office prior to issuance of your number.
- The entry and biosecurity form on the reverse side must be filled out for each horse/pony completely, legibly and signed with three signatures. All entry fees are per class unless otherwise noted.
- Incomplete entry forms will be charged a post-entry fee (i.e., please do not use "same" when completing the entry forms, as they will be deemed incomplete).
- A negative Coggins dated no earlier than 1 May 2017 and, per USEF Rule GR845, health records of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within prior six months must be presented to the secretary stand upon arrival to the show grounds. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by management.
- A Social Security number or Federal ID number for prize money payee must be entered on the entry form, or checks will not be issued.
- A \$25 Grounds/Office/EMT fee will be applied to all entries.
- Entries postmarked after 26 April 2018 will be charged a \$25 post-entry fee. Post-entries made the day of the class will be accepted at management's discretion and must be made in the horse show office.
- All riders competing in classes restricted to amateurs must present current USEF amateur certification before numbers are issued. Photocopies are acceptable.
- All classes for juniors are limited to exhibitors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of 1 December 2017.
- In order to compete in any recognized USEF/USHJA class as an exhibitor, rider, trainer or agent(s), a person must be a member of the USEF and USHJA or pay a Show Pass fee of \$45 to USEF and \$30 to USHJA, including USHJA Outreach members.
- Jumper Nomination Fee: All jumpers entered in 1.10 meter classes and above must pay a nomination fee of \$50.
- Pony measurement cards or a valid measurement form are required for Children's Hunter Pony and Junior Hunter divisions. Pony measurements will be done by the on-call veterinarian from approximately 9:00 AM 12:00 PM the day of the show. To schedule a measurement, please contact the Show Secretary at 610-469-0227 or email horseshow@kimbertonhunt.org.

NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED UNTIL THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS ARE MET

- Schooling will be permitted only in areas provided by the committee.
- The entry fee is \$15 for Blue/Red Warm Up classes, which replaces schooling in the show ring.
- Horses showing in classes in which they have not been properly entered will be charged an additional \$20 office fee per class and will not be considered for an award.
- Returned Checks: A penalty of \$25 will be assessed for any check returned by the bank for any reason.
- Scratches: Classes must be scratched in the horse show office a minimum of two classes prior to the star't of the class in order to receive credit at no charge. Horses/ponies that scratch once the class has begun or at the in gate or do not show in classes in which they have been entered will forfeit their entry fees and will be charged a \$20 office fee.
- No refunds on classes with prize money once the order of go has been established or division has started.
- To be eligible for a stake class, the exhibitor must show in at least one other over fence class in the same division.
- For all sanctioned classes other than USEF pointed classes, such as NAL and M&S, horse and rider combination must enter at least one other class at that same show.
- Dogs: All dogs must be restrained on a leash. The owner of any dog found loose will be fined \$50 and will be responsible for the entry fees of any exhibitor disrupted. All dogs must have current rabies tags.
- Parking will be allowed in designated areas only.
- In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, biohazardous medical waste containers will be provided at the secretary stand. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of this waste.
- USEF Fee Statement: Per USEF Rule GR407.1-3, for every horse participating in any competition licensed by the USEF, a \$23 Federation Fee will be collected (\$15 shall be an Equine Drugs & Medication Fee to provide for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs).
- USEF Membership Statement: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Federation Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith and all other appropriate governing organizations.

- The rated sections and classes of this competition are official USEF point competitions for USHJA Stirrup Cup Championships and USHJA Zone Horse of the Year Awards Programs. In addition, PHSA, CCHSA, ISSO, NAL, FHSS and M&S points will be awarded in classes so indicated in the prize list.
- The Kimberton Hunt Club Horse Show Committee (KHC Committee) reserves the right in itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the KHC Committee, their decision to be final. All protests will be handled in accordance with USEF Rules and Regulations. The USEF protest fee is \$200 if made by a member and \$300 if made by a non-member.
- The KHC Committee reserves the right to limit entries, refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a mandatory line, to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or judges; to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule or as competition warrants, or make any changes the KHC Committee deems is in the best interest of the show and its exhibitors. Should any question or dispute arise that is not provided for in the rules, the same shall be referred to the KHC Committee whose direction shall be final.
- Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the KHC Committee, The
 KHC Horse Show and its Committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage that
 may occur, or any accident that might occur to any rider, driver, groom or attendant, animal
 or equipment at the show, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall
 hold the KHC Horse Show, its members, directors and employees, contractors, sponsoring
 entities and facility harmless for any loss or accident to horse, horses or equipment which
 may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.
- While every effort has been made to avoid mistakes in this publication, the USEF and the KHC Committee assume no liability to anyone for errors. Any significant errors or changes will be disclosed to competitors whose entries are accepted upon their acceptance, and otherwise in accordance with the most current USEF Rules.
- Time Schedule: The time schedule and order of events contained herein is tentative. The KHC Committee reserves the right to combine, cancel or reschedule classes in accordance with applicable rules. No class will be delayed more than 10 minutes to accommodate an exhibitor. Exhibitors are responsible for having entries ready to compete at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time of any class or session. Exhibitors must make arrangements with the paddock masters before their class commences to adjust for conflict.
- Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges, officials or volunteers on the part of the owner, manager, rider, trainer, coach or groom may disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit all entry and other fees.
- Poling: Manual poling and the use of bamboo offsets are prohibited at all times on the grounds. Any rider, trainer, groom, or any other person who is in of a violation of this rule and the involved horse will be fined \$500 for each incident and may be suspended from further competition. In addition, no refunds will be given for any unused fees.

- Championships: The champion and reserve champion titles will be awarded in accordance with USEF Rules and Regulations and will be presented at the completion of each division.
- Eight ribbons will be pinned in all classes, unless otherwise stated. Trophies or prize money will be awarded as specified in the Prize List. Designated prize money will be given at the completion of each class. Checks must be cashed within thirty days of the show or they will not be honored.

SAFETY

Accidents Involving Competitors: GR1317. In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a licensed competition, the competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional. The competitor may be placed on suspension by USEF until this criteria is met. Competitors are advised to familiarize themselves with this new rule. It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASEI (Safety Equipment Institute)/ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. See USEF GR801. It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent, guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.



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HUNTER DIVISION

- Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness. A vet may be consulted to decide soundness of a horse in the hunter classes. The decision of the judge is final.
- Hunter courses will consist of at least eight fences with changes of direction. Fences will simulate obstacles found in the hunt field, such as brush, post and rails, walls, in and outs, gates, etc. No bank or water jumps.
- Course diagrams will be posted no later than 30 minutes before the class.
- In some cases, the area of the courtesy circle may be restricted by a mandatory line.
- Under saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. No martingales permitted.
- In Amateur Owner and Junior classes, entries may be asked to hand gallop collectively one way of the ring, at the Judge's discretion. No more than eight shall be asked to hand gallop at one time.
- Minimum entry requirements: Management reserves the right to combine sections with less than three entries.

JUMPER DIVISION

- Open to all horses and ponies and riders.
- To be run in accordance with USEF tables and rules and other sanctioning agencies.
- The order of go will be generated by random by computer in the office and will be posted at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the class/division.
- All ties involving first place shall be jumped off. All ties for placings other than first in all jumper classes will be broken by the first round time.
- The time allowed is based on 350 meter/minute for all jumper classes.
- Jumper courses may include verticals, gates, oxers or other spread obstacles, wall, panels, coops, water or any other combination or variations. At all heights, to qualify as a spread fence, the fence must be 5cm (2") up to 15cm (6") wider.
- There will be a course walk before the division only.
